We have deployed on a maximum four-node cluster. We are using a Java server engine and we have deployed in multiple low-clusters.

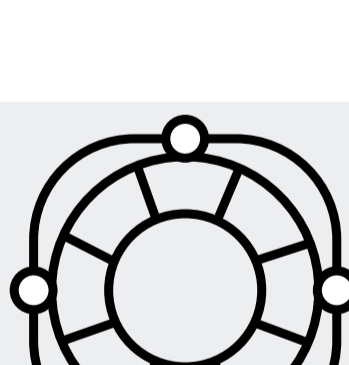
